Современная лексика и коллоквиализмы

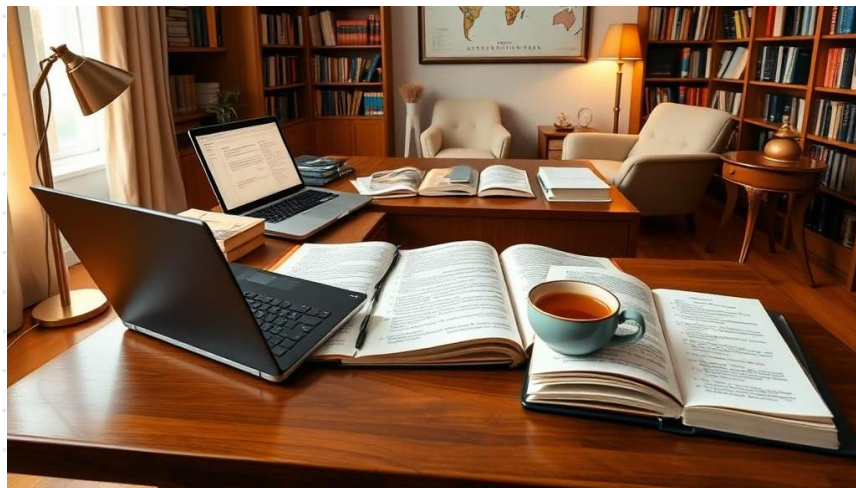

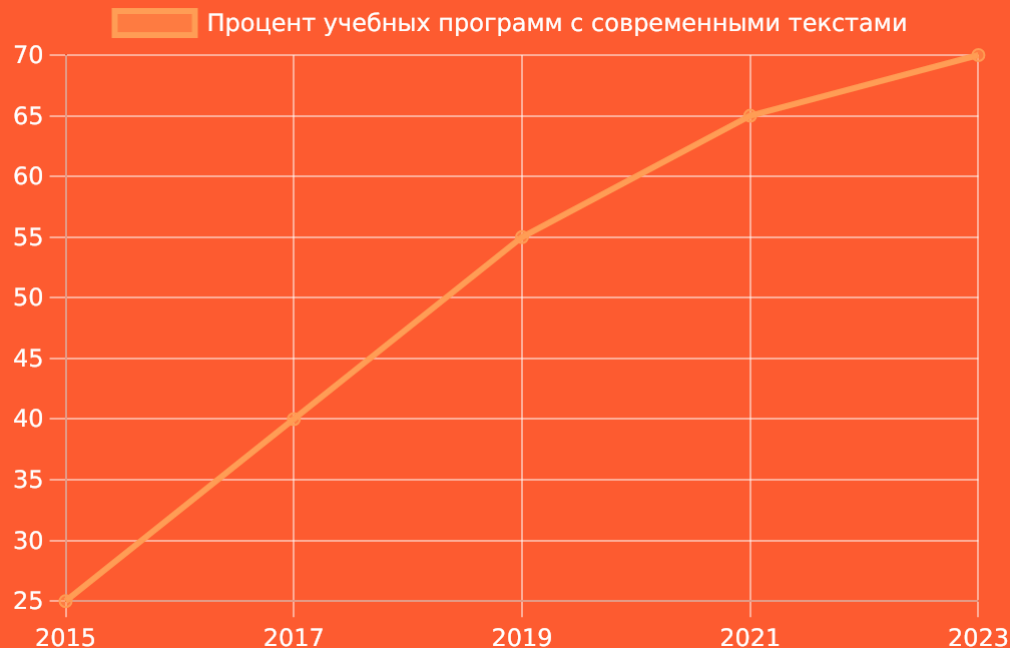

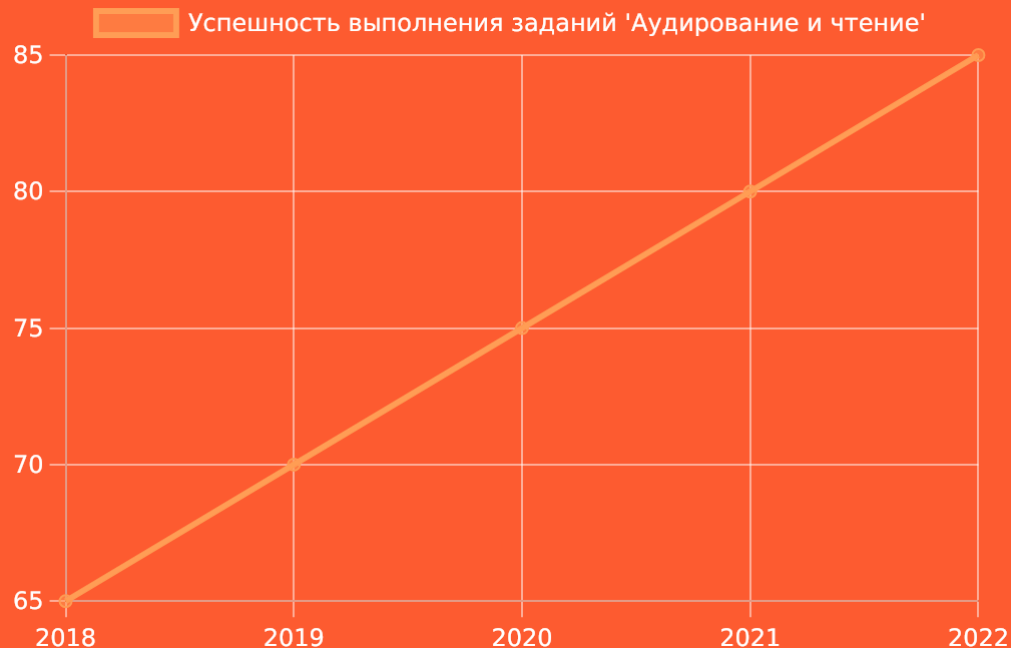


Динамика улучшения результатов ЕГЭ
